-April 30<sup>th</sup> is the deadline for rescheduling games for the season.

-Reminder that PS1 forms are needed for RELEASES, TRANSFERS, and SECONDARY players. You can print the form from the download section. Please fill out the form completely including team ID#, player ID#. Please fill out a player fee sheet as well.

-Make sure when adding a coach to a team that you upload a picture immediately.

-Make sure names/birthdates MATCH the birth certificate.

-Referee fees will be increasing for the FALL 2018 season.

-CPYSL will use a single referee fee for U9-U10-U11-U12-division 2 and below and a 3 man referee system for U12-division 1 and above.

-Please remind your parents and coaches to reach out to their clubs, not CPYSL. Only the board members should reach out to the CPYSL office.

-EPYSA tryout period was discussed. Proposal would be that after the last game of the spring season to August would be considered as a "tryout" period for the player. Discussion held...would not work well due to having rosters/passes done on time plus ordering uniforms. This concept is being done in academy teams.

-CPYSL would like to start a grant/scholarship program for CPYSL clubs and players. Jim would like to have input and ideas from clubs about how the money should be given, he would like something in place by 2019. Look on EPYSA for ideas. Dirk Storie from Fusion will look into guidelines for a grant program and Deb Remeikas from Tuscarora Youth Soccer Club will look into guidelines for scholarships.
