**Registrar (Wendy Campbell)**

- End of Season Fall Financials was distributed to the clubs during the first week of December. An email was sent to the clubs with the amount owed. About 20 clubs still owe money, please make payments in order to avoid additional late fee fines.
- Spring 2018 PRELIMINARY team counts are due January 5<sup>th</sup>
- Spring 2018 FINAL team counts are due February 2<sup>nd</sup>
- Spring 2018 Season begins on April 7/8<sup>th</sup> and ends on June 9/10<sup>th</sup>
- Some divisions with uneven brackets will cause your last game to be pushed to the weekend of June 16/17<sup>th</sup> since this is late in the season...these games will be made as a TBA. Teams having a TBA will need to work together and request a reschedule in the CPYSL website. There will be no fee for this game rescheduling.
- Spring competition meeting will be held on Wednesday, February 7<sup>th</sup> at 7pm
- U13/14's will play on SATURDAYS in the spring.
- League fees are due on February 9<sup>th</sup> for all teams playing in the spring league, two new forms should accompany the payment. Wendy explained the forms.

### **District Commissioner (Donna Outt)**

-Jim will discuss items from EPYSA.

### **President (Jim Conners)**

-Announced that Wendy is the administrator of the year for EPYSA. She will attend the awards banquet in February.

-Jim, Wendy, and Karen attended an EPYSA meeting for leagues. Blue Star registration may be the future registration engine. EPYSA will be increasing their registration fees for the fall 2018. There has not been an increase since 2008 for travel players and 2005 for intramural/rec players.

-EPYSA has a focus group studying cups and being over crowded with league play, tournament, tryouts, and other events.

-Discussion held on minority/low income players and what EPYSA is doing to promote participation for these players who can't afford "pay to play" clubs.

-EPYSA AGM will be held February 25<sup>th</sup> in Philadelphia. See their website for further information. Clubs with intramural and recreational players must attend in order to avoid a fine from EPYSA.

-EPYSA is accepting applications until April 6<sup>th</sup> for scholarships and grants for clubs and players. They have \$75,000 total to give out.

-CPYSL would like to start a grant/scholarship program for CPYSL clubs and players. Jim would like to have input and ideas from clubs about how the money should be given, he would like something in place by 2019.

- Playing time concerns: Jim continues to receive emails from parents. He advocates that under 12's receive 50% playing time. Discussion was held about not keeping standings for the lower divisions, loss of rec divisions for clubs. He would like help from clubs to work on a guideline for playing time.
- Discussion held on how to promote referee school within club's communities.

### **New Business/Club Reports**

- Area to "post" the need for players on certain teams.

Election of Officers for 2018, Michelle Klein from PA Classics has volunteered to head the nominating committee for the AGM meeting in January. Each year, membership will vote in board of directors. This year, President, VP of Programs, Treasurer, and 5 Board of Directors are up for re-election
